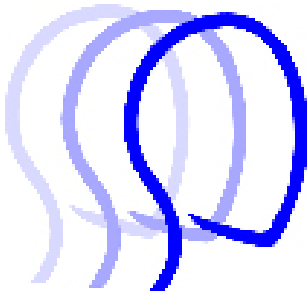


## Our Mission & Our Membership
